

ORDINANCE NO. 109

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT PARKING IN CERTAIN AREAS BETWEEN SPECIFIED HOURS.

THE VILLAGE OF PERRINTON ORDAINS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on Robinson Street, in the Village of Perrinton, from its intersection with Elba Street, south to its intersection with Allor Street, between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

Section 2. Penalty. Any violation of this ordinance by any person shall, upon conviction, be punishable by a fine not exceeding \$100.00, or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 90 days, or both.

Section 3. SEPARABILITY. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 4. ORDINANCES REPEALED. All ordinances and/or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 20 days from and after its enactment as provided by the Village Council.
