

ORDINANCE 111

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE KEEPING OF LIVESTOCK, FUR-BEARING ANIMALS, AND POULTRY, WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF PERRINTON.

THE VILLAGE OF PERRINTON ORDAINS:

Section 1. Except in those areas designated as agricultural by the Gratiot County Zoning Ordinance or Fulton Township Zoning Ordinance or those areas occupied and used as agricultural land pursuant to a valid preexisting conforming use from such zoning ordinances, no person shall keep or harbor within the Village limits of the Village of Perrinton, any livestock, including but not limited to horses, cattle, goats, sheep, swine or any other form of livestock kept ordinarily as livestock.

Section 2. No person shall keep or harbor within the Village limits of the Village of Perrinton, any poultry or fowl, including but not limited to, ducks, chickens, geese or any other fowl.

Section 3. No person shall keep or harbor within the Village limits of the Village of Perrinton, any fur-bearing animals, whether kept for the purpose of harvesting furs or slaughtering for food.

Section 4. Notwithstanding the foregoing, it shall be lawful for any person in the Village of Perrinton to keep domestic pets upon premises owned or occupied by them, such as dogs and cats. It shall further be lawful for any person within the Village to keep domestic pets such as small birds, fish, hamsters or other domestic pets routinely kept indoors.

Section 5. Separability. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is, for any reason, held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 6. Ordinances Repealed. All ordinances and/or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 7. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 15 days from and after its enactment as provided by the Village Charter.

Passed and approved by the Village of Perrinton, Michigan, in regular session, held July 1, 1985.
