AN ORDINANCE REGULATION THE OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES IN THE VILLAGE OF PERRINTON, MICHIGAN AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

THE VILLAGE OF PERFINTON ORDAINS:

# SECTION 1 - OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILE WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF PERRINTON, MICHIGAN.

A. No person shall operate a snowmobile defined as any motor vehicle designed for travel primarily on snow or ice of a type which utilizes sled type runners or skies, or on an endless belt tread or any combination of these or simular means of contact with the surface upon which it is operated:

- 1. On any street right of way, boundary line to boundary line, nor on any sidewalk or area designated or maintaine for pedestrian travel, nor on any alley publicly maintained.
- 2. Within 100 feet of a dwelling between 12 midnight and 6:00 a.m. at a speed greater than minimum required to maintain forward movement of the snowmobile.
- 3. In or upon or remain unlavfully on premises which fenced, otherwise enclosed in a manner to exclude intruders, posted in a conspicuous manner, or when notice against trespass is personally commuted to him by the owner or an autorized person. A person shall not operate a snowmobile in or upon farm lands, farm wood lots, or platted property without the permission of the owner.
- 4. At a rate of speed greater than is reasonable and proper having due regard for conditions then existing.
- 5. That under the influence of intoxication liquor or narcotic drugs, barbital or any drivative of barbital.
- 6. During the hours from one-half after sunset to one-half hour before sunrise without displaying a lighted headlight and a lighted taillight.

#### B. PENALTIES:

Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment of not more than ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

C. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict here with are hereby repealed.

D. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, apprival and publication according to the laws of the State of Michigan.
