

ORDINANCE NO. One

An Ordinance to control and prohibit contamination and pollution to the municipal water supply wells and water system of the City of Perrinton, and to provide a penalty for the violation of this Ordinance.

THE CITY OF Perrinton ORDAINS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to construct or maintain, or permit to be constructed or maintained, within a radius of two hundred (200) feet from any of the municipal water wells within the City of Perrinton from which the City draws its water supplies, any source of possible contamination or pollution to said wells.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to do any act, or to allow to be done any act, that may contaminate or pollute or contribute to the contamination or pollution of the water supply wells or water system of the City of Perrinton.

Section 3. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, and costs of prosecution, or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a term of not exceeding ninety (90) days, or both, such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court.

Section 4. This Ordinance is declared to be immediately necessary properly to protect the health and safety of the public, and shall take effect on and after twenty-one (21) days from the date of passage.

An Ordinance to control and prohibit contamination and pollution to the municipal water supply wells and water system of the Village of Perrinton and to provide a penalty for the violation of this Ordinance.

THE VILLAGE OF PERRINTON ORDAINS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to construct or maintain, or permit to be constructed or maintained, within a radius of one hundred (100) feet from any of the municipal water wells within the Village of Perrinton from which the City draws its water supply any source of possible contamination or pollution to said wells.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to do any act, or to allow to be done any act, that may contaminate or pollute or contribute to the contamination or pollution of the water supply wells or water system of the Village of Perrinton.

Section 3. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, and costs of prosecution, or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a term of not exceeding ninety(90) days, or both, such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court.

Section 4. This Ordinance is declared to be immediately necessary properly to protect the health and safety of the public, and shall take effect on and after twenty-one (21) days from the date of passage.
