RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING NON-MOTORIZED TRANSPORTATION
IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, the Village of Perrinton, State of Michigan receives Act 51 funds from the State of Michigan, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Perrinton is currently in non-compliance with the Actual qualified expenditures for Non-motorized Improvements Section 10k of the Act 51 law, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Perrinton, in order to achieve compliance with the State of Michigan, Section 10k of the Act 51 law must present a plan to exceed at least \$3366.30 within the next three years on non-motorized transportation improvements, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Perrinton after reviewing the Reporting Guidelines for Non-motorized Transportation Expenditures of the State of Michigan, Street Financial Report and the needs of the populace does hereby submit the following proposal:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Village of Perrinton hereby submit to the State of Michigan a plan to :

Repair/Replace Sidewalks ...

1. 136' x 4' (544 sq ft) @ \$4.50 – Along north side of Elba St. between Robinson St. and Alley
Estimated cost - \$2448
2. 132' x 12' (1584 sq ft) @ \$4.50 – Along east side of Robinson St. from Elba St. 132' to the north
Estimated cost - \$7128
3. 70' x 5' (350 sq ft) @ \$4.50 – Along east side of Robinson St. from Fulton St. 70' to the south
Estimated cost - \$1575
4. 280' x 11' (3080 sq ft) @ \$3.00 – Along west side of Robinson St. from Fulton St. to Elba St.
Estimated cost - \$9240
5. 280' x 11' (3080 sq ft) @ \$3.00 – Along west side of Robinson St. from Fulton St. to Railroad St.
Estimated cost - \$9240
