

Resolution No. 94-03-07

Village of Perrinton,

Fulton Township, Gratiot County, Michigan

A RESOLUTION of the Perrinton Village Council to local zoning authorities, requesting Wellhead Protection considerations set down by Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) guidelines or at such a time the state has an approved EPA, Wellhead Protection Program (WHP). EPA guidelines will be weighed in making permits and zoning, subdivision and other related land use ordinance, regulations, or decisions until a time allowing the Village of Perrinton to draft their own WHP Zoning Ordinance.

1. WHEREAS, The Village of Perrinton recognizes it's Groundwater supply as a natural resource; and
2. WHEREAS, it is within the responsibility of the Village as a public water supplier, to consider the health, safety, and welfare of its customers; and
3. WHEREAS, groundwater contamination can and does occur as a consequence of a variety of land use activities; and
4. WHEREAS, it is desirable to preserve and protect the quantity and quality of our groundwater resources to assure a continued safe, adequate, and usable supply, now and in the future; and
5. WHEREAS, the protection of current and potential future sources of groundwater is worthwhile from the standpoint of resource protection;

Now, therefore, be it resolved by Perrinton Village Council we do respectfully ask the Zoning Authorities at the Village, Township and County levels. That all new and/or additional land use within the Village limits, and buliding permits issued comply with all present State and/or Federal WHP guidlines.

Be it also resolved, this Resolution be in affect for a period of 1 year from the date below and will be reviewed at this time. The type of progress being made in the effort of identifying and zoning the " zone of contribution" to the Municipal Wells.

Be it also resolved the only override of this resolution can and will be of a Zoning Ordinance for Wellhead Protection.
